Courses Offered will...

- Satisfy OSHA and EPA training requirements.
- Provide valuable information on equipment operation

You will complete Lift Truck Operator Safety Training & OSHA requirements 1 & 2 only at this class. Section 3 must be completed at your facility to insure full compliance. You will need to schedule this with the instructor at the conclusion of the training.

- Provide respirator training and fit-testing. A medical evaluation for clearance is required prior to the fit testing. A link for a medical evaluation will be sent to you if you do not have one already. (EPA requires medical clearance for the initial fitting, and not again unless noted by the physician or a change in health or weight.
- Provide American Heart Association Heartsaver AED First Aid training. (CPR) WVDA will pay the cost of the card.
- Provide agricultural pesticide safety training materials and requirements in accordance with the ***new updated*** EPA Worker Protection Standards (worker, handler and trainers).
