Dear Applicant,

The West Virginia Department of Agriculture (WVDA) will be accepting applications to grow Industrial Hemp in **October and November**. Due to the time required for review of the applications, completion of background checks, application for required permits, and shipping, no applications will be accepted after November 30, 2017 for the 2018 growing season. (*Applications for larger acreage may be favorable.*)

Once applications have been reviewed a decision will be made to:

- 1) Issue a Provisional License. The WVDA will then deposit your registration fee and send you further instructions and additional requirements.
- 2) Decline to issue, for whatever reason. The WVDA will refund your payment with a brief description.

An application fee of 100 dollars is required in addition to 5 dollars for every acre of crop you intend to grow. A check for the total amount should be included with the completed application upon submission. Applications without a check included will be considered incomplete and will not be considered.

Additional **sampling/testing fees will apply later in the growing season** to verify the chemical content in the crop is below the allowed THC concentration for Industrial Hemp. Currently, the testing fee = \$150 /sample (multiple samples may be required). Driving and sampling time will be charged at the rate of \$70/hour (Two inspectors at \$35.00/hour). Driving time will be measured from Charleston to your location/s and return to Charleston. (See the *Projected Sampling Cost* spreadsheet on the following page for more details.

Application for Research and Marketing Cultivation of Industrial Hemp

The West Virginia Industrial Hemp Development Act (Chapter 19, Article 12 of the Code of West Virginia, as amended) governs the production and distribution of plant material commonly known as Industrial Hemp. Under the provisions of the Industrial Hemp Development Act, plants specifically identified as *Cannabis sativa* L. containing no more than 1% tetrahydrocannabinol, or the current limit allowed by federal law (whichever is more restrictive), and are used solely for the purposes authorized by the Act, are regulated by the West Virginia Department of Agriculture (WVDA). It is unlawful for anyone to produce or distribute plants or parts of plants commonly known as industrial hemp unless that person has first secured a certificate of registration from the Commissioner of Agriculture.
