Frequently Asked Questions

I want to open a pet treat company. What do I need to do?

To sell pet treats, you must:

- 1. **Obtain a Guaranteed Analysis** Have your product analyzed by an independent lab for:
 - Minimum Crude Protein
 - o Minimum Crude Fat
 - Maximum Crude Fiber
 - o Maximum Moisture
- 2. Ensure Your Label Includes the Following:
 - o **Product name** and brand name (if applicable)
 - o Species statement specifying the intended pet (e.g., "for dogs")
 - o Quantity statement (by weight, liquid measure, or count)
 - o Guaranteed Analysis
 - o Ingredient statement (must use AAFCO-approved or FDA GRAS ingredients)
 - o Statement of nutritional adequacy or purpose (if required)
 - Feeding directions
 - o Manufacturer/distributor name and address (city, state, zip code)

This information can be found in Commercial Feed Law 19-14-8 and the AAFCO Official Publication.

- 3. Submit Your Label & Application:
 - Once your label is complete, submit it with the correct application and fee or pay online.

Mock Label Example:

Product Name/Brand: Howard's Peanut Butter Dog Treats (Must feature a dog image, not a cat or horse, if including a picture.)

Guaranteed Analysis:

• Crude Protein: 16.3% (min.)

• Crude Fat: 14.2% (min.)

• **Crude Fiber**: 3.4% (max.)

• **Moisture**: 16.4% (max.)

Ingredients (in order of predominance): Peanut Butter, Flour, Salt, etc.

Manufacturer Information:

Howard's Dog Treats 123 Main Street Petland, WV 25319 (Phone number or email-Optional)

Quantity Statement: 1 lb

Additional Labeling Rules:

- "Proven" cannot be used unless supported by scientific evidence.
- No false or misleading comparisons between products.
- Terms like "Improved" or "New" can only be used for six months after production.

Registration Requirements

I am selling pet food in both 5 lb. and 15 lb. packages. Do I need to register both?

Yes. Products must be registered separately under Small Package Pet and Large Package Pet categories.

I am selling pet food in 3 lb. and 5 lb. packages. Do I need to register both?

No. Both products fall under **Small Package Pet** (under 10 lbs.) and require only **one** registration.

I am selling 3 oz. dog biscuits in bulk. How do I register them?

Bulk products must be registered under Large Package Pet, as they are distributed in non-packaged form.

I am selling small, large, and jumbo treats. Do I need to register each size separately?

Yes. Each treat size (small, medium, large, etc.) must be **registered individually**, and a label must be provided for each.

Late Fee Policy

Can the late fee be waived?

No. Late fees are established under **West Virginia Code 19-14-5**, and the Department of Agriculture has **no authority** to waive or alter them.
