Information for Certification Applicants

The Nutrient Management Certification Program is a voluntary program available to individuals with the expertise to provide nutrient management technical assistance to the agricultural community.

Nutrient Management Certification Exam Application Requirements

- I. To apply for the certification exam, an applicant shall file form NMP2 with the WV Department of Agriculture at least 30 calendar days <u>prior to</u> the announced examination date. (1st Friday of February)
- II. The completed application form shall be mailed to:

- III. Once an application is processed, the applicant will receive an exam registration confirmation. The notice will include the date and location of the certification examination.
- IV. The applicant must also submit proof and have either:
 - 1. Five years of nutrient management practical experience working with farmers and an unrelated degree or no degree; or
 - 2. Three years of practical experience and a two year associates degree in an agricultural related field; or
 - 3. One year of experience and a baccalaureate degree in an agricultural related field (Agriculture or Natural Resources).
- V. Verification of nutrient management experience must be included. Nutrient management experience must be listed as a percentage of the time the individual performs actual work in the field of nutrient management. The following is an example:
 - a. John Q. Consultant Central Consultants (Title Land Use Planner) -4 years.
 - 1. 20% Writing nutrient management plans
 - 2. 20% Administrative duties
 - 3. 40% Land use planning
 - 4. 20% Other duties as assigned

TOTAL 100

- 1. Summary: 4 years X .20= .80 years
- 2. In this case the individual needs another .20 years of experience.
- VI. Current or former employers who supervised the applicant's nutrient management activities must verify experience. Transcripts indicating college work may be requested when education is used to meet eligibility requirements.
- VII. Upon passing the nutrient management exam, the individual's credentials will be reviewed for meeting the items IV and V listed above.
 - a. If an individual does not meet the above criteria, the individual will be notified of the area of deficiency and the individual will have a period of three years to meet the education or experience requirements.
 - 1. If the individual does not meet the requirements within the three year period, the individual will be required to retake the exam.
 - b. Upon passing credential review, the individual will be issued a WV Nutrient Management Consultant Certificate.
