Jenny L. Carder was born in Hundred, West Virginia. She has spent the past 56 years directly involved in state organizations that have had and continue to have an impact on the state's agriculture industry. Carter participates in beef industry promotion events throughout the state such as the State Fair of WV and the WV Beef Cook-Off.
