## Certification to the Commissioner

Recent changes to 61CSR26-4.1 require that all industrial hemp licensees provide a copy of their license to the local WV State Police Detachment and the county sheriff, where the crop is grown. This letter certifies to the Commissioner of Agriculture that the licensee has met those requirements and must be returned to the WVDA within 60 days of the issue date on the license.
