TREE-OF-HEAVEN IS AN INVASIVE PLANT!



Be on the lookout for tree-of-heaven to **REDUCE** spotted lanternfly!



LEARN TO IDENTIFY IT!

Tree-of-heaven has fissured bark that resembles the surface of a cantaloupe melon, long leaves and the seeds (samaras) on female trees are 1-to-2-inches long with a wing shape.





CUT IT DOWN!

It is best to cut down tree-of-heaven to ensure the spotted lanternflies will not multiply.



APPLY HERBICIDE!

Immediately apply herbicide to freshly cut stumps to prevent excessive regrowth of the plant.



CHECK ANNUALLY!

Check the following year for any root sprouts and apply herbicide to those as well.
