

# TREE-OF-HEAVEN IS AN INVASIVE PLANT!



Be on the lookout for tree-of-heaven  
to **REDUCE** spotted lanternfly!



## LEARN TO IDENTIFY IT!

Tree-of-heaven has fissured bark that resembles the surface of a cantaloupe melon, long leaves and the seeds (samaras) on female trees are 1-to-2-inches long with a wing shape.



## CUT IT DOWN!

It is best to cut down tree-of-heaven to ensure the spotted lanternflies **will not** multiply.



## APPLY HERBICIDE!

Immediately apply herbicide to freshly cut stumps to prevent excessive regrowth of the plant.



## CHECK ANNUALLY!

Check the following year for any root sprouts and apply herbicide to those as well.
