Application for Entry Permit for the Importation of Honey Bees and Beekeeping Equipment

Pursuant to §19-13-7b of the Code of West Virginia, it shall be unlawful for any person to transport bees, used bee equipment or used appliances into West Virginia, unless accompanied by a certificate of inspection signed by an authorized state or federal inspection official verifying the actual inspection of the bees, used bee equipment or used appliances within 30 days preceding the date of shipment and certifying the absence of honey bee pests. The Commissioner of the West Virginia Department of Agriculture (WVDA) will issue the permit of entry when the following information is furnished by the owner:
